The CDE was followed by Hands on session for the participants training for use of zirconia crowns in dentistry.

A total of 147 delegates were registered, out of which 139 participated in the workshop divided into 3 batches for 3 days. All the participants will be getting the certificate of participation from Indian Resuscitation Council Federation as well as from SGT University.
