

To create awareness among the people about common oral diseases and to Promote Oral Health.



7. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s) explaining activities undertaken:

An oral health screening and treatment camp was organized by Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University on 12th January, 2023 (Thursday) at Ladpur Village in association with Reliance MET. The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head and Associate Dean). The Dental team was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry) along with 2 postgraduates Dr. Ayesha (Department of Prosthodontics), Dr. Virender (Department of Oral Surgery), 6 Interns- Reetika, Nikita, Nisha, Prachi, Palak, Rashmit and 1 attendant - Mr. Sunil from PHD department. A total of 102 patients were examined which included 47 males and 55 females. Of which 25 patients were provided treatment (23 oral prophylaxis and 2 extractions) in Mobile Dental Van on camp site. Patients who required complex treatment were referred to Dental Hospital in SGT University. Oral health education was *imparted to the people and proper brushing technique was demonstrated* to both adult and child patients. Toothbrushes, toothpastes, oral mouthwashes were distributed to the needy population.

The general population gave positive feedback and appreciated the check up and treatment provided by the Dental Team. They acknowledged the way the Dental team heard and attended to their problems with compassion and were appreciative of the oral health education and counselling disseminated to them. The interns appreciated the opportunity provided to them to interact with patients at a community setting leading to improvement in their soft skills and approach towards patients in an outreach location, they also expressed their wish to participate in such activities in the future. The purpose of the dental camp was to create awareness in the community towards the importance of oral

- 8. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words): SGT University conducted oral health workshop and screening programme on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023(Wednesday) at Mother's Pride School, Pataudi. The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head). The Dental team was headed by Dr. Meenakshi Chopra (Associate Professor) along with 2 post Graduate, 8 Interns and 2 Attendants. The camp started at 10:30 am and continued till 2:00 pm. The Workshop conducted for the students of Mothers pride school witnessed a lot of enthusiasm and interest on the part of students during the interactive session and a quiz on oral health held by the interns under the guidance of Dr Meenakshi. At the end of session, a token of appreciation was given to the students for their active participation in the quiz. Screening of a total 298 students was carried out which included 165 boys and 133 girls. Students who required dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental hospital for further treatment. Prophylactic aids such as toothbrush and toothpaste were also distributed to the students. The principal and staff members showed acknowledgment for the informative and resourceful screening process with an appreciation letter and warm hospitality.

**CAMP REPORT** 

SUNDAY OUTREACH ACTIVITY

29<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2023

Jaitpur Village, Rewari

The Department of Public Health Dentistry of Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University conducted Oral health screening and Treatment program on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at the Government School, Jaitpur Village, Rewari. The camp was organized by the efforts of locals from the village and especially Mr. Amit Rao.

The Dental team was headed by Dr Shourya Tandon (Professor & Head and Associate Dean) along with Dr. Ankita Thakur (Tutor), Postgraduate Dr Shivansh (Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics), 10 Interns (Aditi, Nisha, Preeti, Garima, Muskan, Rashmit, Tanisha, Swati, Ranika & Lokesh) and 2 attendant Mr Sunil & Mr. Sombir. Appropriate prior information about the activity was provided to villagers and nearby people and local arrangements were coordinated by the Publicity Team division of SGT University

Overall around 350 patients visited the camp site wherein apart from Dental Services departments, consultations from Medical Sciences and Medicine Dispensing through Pharmacy division were also undertaken. A total of 123 patients were examined for dental issues, out of which 23 patients were provided dental treatment (Oral Prophylaxis, Restorations and Tooth Removals) in the mobile dental van. Around 18 patients were identified for Oral Rehabilitative Services, 60 for Tooth Decay and Restorations, 20 for tooth removal procedures and almost all for gum related concerns. To around 50 of these patients Toothpaste, Toothbrush & mouthwash samples were distributed free of cost along with individual level Oral Health Education to each through IEC materials.

Each of the visiting patients were issued Referral Slips as part of Social Oral Health Service scheme under which they would be able to avail special discounts for their specific dental treatments at the SGT University campus Dental Clinics.

The Administrative Panchayat authorities also visited the camp site and appreciated the efforts being undertaken by the Health Teams from SGT university for alleviation of Oral Health and other issues from the people residing at the village. The general population also gave positive feedback and appreciated the check up and patient care provided by the Dental Team.



Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s) explaining activities undertaken: An oral health screening and treatment camp was organized by Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University on 8th February, 2023 (Wednesday) at Yakubpur Village in association with Reliance MET. The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head and Associate Dean). Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Assistant Professor) headed the dental team along with 2 postgraduates Dr. Preetika (Department of Oral Medicine), Dr. Gaurav (Department of Oral Pathology), 6 interns- Nikita, Prateek, Pawan, Garima, Sakshi, Muskan. 2 attendants accompanied the dental team- Mr. Sunil and Mr. Darshan. The team left the college at 9:15 am and reached the venue at 10:15 am. The screening commenced at 10:25 am. Total 69 patients were examined. Twenty patients were provided treatment (oral prophylaxis) in Mobile dental van on camp site. Along with screening, health talk was delivered simultaneously on how to take care of the teeth, importance of brushing and proper brushing technique. Toothbrushes, toothpastes,



oral mouthwashes were distributed to the needy population. Satisfactory feedback was obtained from the general population. All queries regarding toothbrushing techniques were explained individually to the patients. The patients cherished the chance to interact with the dentists to enquire and gain knowledge about their oral health and maintaining good oral hygiene. The patients were also given referral slips and were referred to SGT University for further needful treatment. The interns appreciated the opportunity provided to them to work in a field setting. The purpose of the dental camp was to create awareness in the community towards the importance of oral health and motivate them for their oral hygiene maintenance. The camp concluded at 2:00 pm. The team left the venue at 2:30 pm and reached the college at 3:00 pm.





#### Mukh Asha Abhiyan – Training for ASHA Workers on Oral Health Promotion

The Dental Division of Samajik Vikas SGT Ka Prayas (SVSP) unit of SGT University, Gurugram has conceptualized to initiate the training for ASHA Workers on Oral Health Promotion. Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences in collaboration with Faculty of Nursing and Faculty of Mass Communication & Media Technology organized the introductory session to sensitize the ASHA workers on Oral Health and its Importance at Community Health Centre, Farukh Nagar, Gurugram on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2023 (Tuesday). The team was headed by Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with Dr. Charu Khurana (Reader, Department of Public Health Dentistry), both of whom have conceptualized this idea of **Mukh ASHA Abhiyan**. Other faculty present were Mr. Naveen Vats (Department of Nursing) and Ms. Neha (Dept. of Mass Communication), 3 BDS Interns- Preeti, Swati, Shalley and 1 attendant Mr. Sunil. Amongst other members from FDSC the project is actively supported by Dr. Omkar Krishna Shetty, Dean; Dr. Bharti Raina and Dr. Anil Gupta.

The dental team enlightened the target audience about the importance of oral health and need of education sessions. With the motive to empower this work force regarding oral health care, SVSP begun the training project with enrollment of 28 ASHA Workers posted in and around villages of Farukh Nagar, Gurugram. The ASHA workers were showcased the state-of-the-art Mobile Dental Van and they also discussed various doubts regarding dental treatment. ASHA Workers appreciated the initiative and showed a great enthusiasm to be a part of the training program on oral health promotion. Many of them also showed their eagerness to collaborate with us for organization of Outreach Dental Care activities at their residential villages.





6. Objective of the Activity:

To create awareness among the people about common oral diseases and to Promote Oral Health.

7. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s) explaining activities undertaken:

The Department of Public Health Dentistry in collaboration with Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University conducted an Oral Cancer Awareness Campaign on 27th



February, 2023 (Monday) at CHC, Farukh Nagar. The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head and Associate Dean). Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Assistant Professor) headed the dental team along with 7 interns- Nisha, Muskan, Sakshi Rai, Sakshi, Reetika, Rashmit, Preeti and 1 attendant accompanied the dental team-Mr. Sunil. Total 90 patients were examined. 6 patients were provided treatment (oral prophylaxis) in Mobile dental van on camp site. 3 patients were also attended for their precancerous lesion/condition with laser treatment by the oral medicine staff and postgraduate students. For the purpose of awareness regarding oral cancer among general populace, Nukkad Natak was performed by the postgraduate, undergraduate students and interns. The camp initiated with dental awareness talk, educating people about common dental ailments, especially stressing on oral cancer. The people were highlighted about the signs and symptoms of oral cancer. Along with screening, health talk was delivered simultaneously on how to take care of the teeth, importance of brushing and proper brushing technique. Toothpastes were distributed to the needy population. Satisfactory feedback was obtained from the community. The patients were also given referral slips and were referred to SGT University for further needful treatment. The purpose of the dental camp was to create awareness in the community towards the importance of oral health as well as oral cancer and concerned related treatment.

The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). The Dental team was headed by Dr. Charu Khurana (Reader, Department of Public Health Dentistry) along with 2 postgraduate students Dr. Divyanshi from Department of Oral Surgery, Dr. Harshita from Department of Prosthodontics and 6 BDS Interns Sakshi, Garima, Preeti, Ankit, Pawan, and Rahul along with 2 attendants Mr. Rajkumar and Mr. Drashan. The dental camp started at 10:30 am and



continued till 1:30 pm.

During the Outreach activity, Oral health status of 103 individuals were examined including 50 males and 53 females and 22 patients were provided professional cleaning of teeth in the Mobile Dental Van of SGT University. Blood sugar level examination was also done for the needy patients. The team also imparted the importance of oral health, routine oral hygiene instructions to all the attendees at the camp.














The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University celebrated World Oral Health Day by organizing dental check-up and treatment camp on 15th March, 2023 (Wednesday) at Divine Dale International School, Sherpur, Pataudi. The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). The dental team was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with 2 postgraduates students Dr. Prince (Dept. of Pedodontics) and Dr. Vidhi (Dept. of Orthodontics) and 6 interns Preeti, Prachi, Prerna, Sakshi, Ankit and Pawan. Two attendants Mr. Sunil and Mr. Darshan accompanied the dental team. Dental checkup of 295 students which included 184 boys and 111 girls was done. 11 students were provided treatment in mobile dental van at camp site. Every year 20th March World Oral Health Day is celebrated dedicated to raising global awareness of the issues around oral health and the importance of oral hygiene. So, on this occasion, oral health talk was rendered by interns with the help of PowerPoint presentation focusing on the importance of maintenance of oral hygiene, toothbrushing techniques, dental-related adverse habits and its consequences, progression and treatment of common oral health diseases in children. Along with this, elements on significance of World Oral Health Day engrossing the theme for this year 'Be Proud of Your Mouth' were included in the presentation and explained to the students through audiovisual aids. In addition to the screening as well as health talk, a quiz was organized and students replying positively and correctly were appreciated with a reward. Demonstration of toothbrushing technique was given. All the students from classes LKG to 12th participated actively with



enthusiasm in each organized activity. The school authority felicitated all the members of the dental team with a token of appreciation.


The camp concluded with a high hope that the team has moved a step forward in creating an orally healthier community.

Children were given demonstrations for brushing technique. Majority of the students had good oral hygiene however some children had Dental Caries, grossly decayed teeth and extrinsic stains.

Proper brushing technique was demonstrated to educate the children and their teachers regarding the importance of proper oral hygiene maintenance. Two hundred and ninety-five students were examined. 





#### <u>undertaken</u>

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University continued their World Oral Health 2023-month long celebration activities and conducted a treatment and follow up session for all the participants who were examined in the previous two visits scheduled on 1st and 8th April, 2023. The session was organized on 15th April, 2023 (Saturday) at Blind Relief Association, New Delhi.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). The dental team on the day was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with 3 interns Garima, Palak, Muskan.

Students from different classes were examined, of which 28 were provided treatment which included oral prophylaxis, GIC and composite restorations. Toothbrushing technique was demonstrated to the individuals using dentoform models.

Over the three visits around 200 school children as well as staffs were screened for their oral health and approximately 60 people were provided with required dental treatment. The camp concluded with a hope that the session will bring a change in behaviour of the students, and they would now start taking preventive measures to avoid dental problems as well as will follow proper oral hygiene instructions given to them.



The association authority appreciated the wholesome efforts and contribution by all the members of the dental team to make the camp successful.

#### 21. Number & Description of Beneficiaries:

The Beneficiaries were students of Blind Relief Association, New Delhi, 28 students came forward for their Dental Check-up and treatment. Children were given demonstrations for brushing technique. Majority of the students had good oral hygiene however some children had Dental Caries, grossly decayed teeth and extrinsic stains.

#### 22. Outcome of the Activity & its relevance to Health Sciences:





Oral Health & CPR Training and Awareness for Residents of Gurgaon

Camp Location: Sector 5, Gurugram

Date: 16th April, 2023 (Sunday)

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with Faculty of Nursing & National Reference Simulation Centre organized a fruitful day of collaborative outreach activity for providing Oral Health Checkup, Dental Treatment and a special session on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Training and Awareness for local residents of Sector 5, Gurugram. Dr. Meenakshi Chopra (Associate Professor) & Dr. Charu Khurana (Associate Professor) headed the dental team on respective days along with 2 Postgraduate Students Dr. Harshita (Post Graduate, Department of Prosthodontics) and Dr. Eshika (Post Graduate, Department of Periodontics) on day one & Dr. Ida (Dept. of Periodontology) and Dr. Sameera (Dept. of Oral Surgery) on day two. BDS Interns - Jatin, Ishan, Mohini, Fiza, Garima, Ragini, Diksha, Livanshi, Jagriti, Lokesh, Mumtaz and 1 attendant- Mr. Sunil actively participated and accompanied the dental team.

Including the 2 days camp at the mentioned location, a total of 224 workers of the manufacturing factory were examined including 45 females and 179 males. Of which, 79 patients were provided treatment (oral prophylaxis) in the Mobile dental van on camp site. All patients suffering from complex dental problems were informed, given referral slips and advised for appropriate dental treatment and referred to the SGT Dental Hospital, Gurugram. Medicines and Oral Hygiene aids such as toothbrush, toothpaste, mouthwashes were also distributed among the attendees of the dental camp.

Along with screening, health talk was also delivered on the importance of Oral Health, Oral hygiene practices, importance of brushing, proper brushing technique, common dental problems, adverse oral habits and preventive remedies. Patients who reported history of tobacco consumption either in any form of smoking or chewing were explained about its injurious effects to not only on their overall health but also harmful to their loved ones around them. Positive feedback was obtained from all the patients who got their treatment done then and there only. The purpose of the dental camp was to create awareness in the community towards the importance of oral health and motivate them to adopt a healthy lifestyle.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with SGT Publicity Team organized a dental as well as medical camp on 12<sup>th</sup> June (Monday),2023 at Suvidha centre New PalamVihar, Gurugram.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). Furthermore, Individuals in need were provide with an oral hygiene package comprising toothpaste, a toothbrush and mouthwash. In addition, Essential medications such as painkillers, antibiotics and multivitamins were dispensed at the camp location

All queries regarding toothbrushing techniques were explained individually to the patients.

Oral Health Awareness, Education and Advise was imparted to all residents at Campsite. Residents expressed gratitude towards the authorities involved in organised the outreach Oral Health Activity and felt motivated towards Positive Oral Health.
